Flexibility in the registration process is key to accommodating different types of events, from large congresses to exclusive C-suite meetings. The speakers stressed the importance of scoping out the project correctly from the start to avoid project creep and ensure that all necessary pathways and data are accounted for.

A significant portion of the discussion focused on the common mistakes and challenges faced during the registration process. These include inadequate scoping, last-minute preparations, and the failure to consider the user journey. The speakers noted that registration often becomes a monster due to project creep and the addition of unforeseen requirements. They recommended prioritising hands-on access to data for clients and ensuring the registration process is fully branded to align with the event or company branding. This helps in maintaining a seamless experience for the attendees and reduces the noise once the registration is launched.

The speakers also highlighted the importance of integrating various tools and systems to streamline the registration process. They mentioned the need for effective project management tools and sheets to share with clients, which helps in defining the registration flow and achieving the data collection goals. The use of logic and formatting to create different pathways was recommended to simplify the user experience, especially for complex events involving multiple ticket types and discount codes. Additionally, they discussed the need for flexibility in the registration platform to handle various event scenarios and attendee types.

Another key point was the role of integrations in managing event data effectively. The need for a dedicated API development team and custom integration scoping process was highlighted to address the varied CRM requirements and ensure data privacy and compliance.

The potential for AI assistants to help with content creation and session selection was mentioned as a way to enhance the user experience. However, they cautioned about the need to balance automation with strategic focus to avoid losing control over the registration process.

The speakers recommended prioritising the scoping process, maintaining hands-on access to data, and using integrations to manage data effectively.
